Books, digital recordings, chapter summaries, and worksheets provided. Meets weekly to discuss one or two chapters that are assigned during the week.

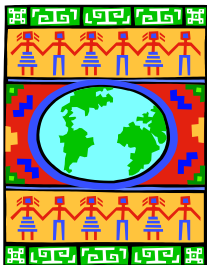
PLEASE inform us if you are new to book club and would like a digital player sent to your house. We will facilitate the set-up through the Talking Books Library.
