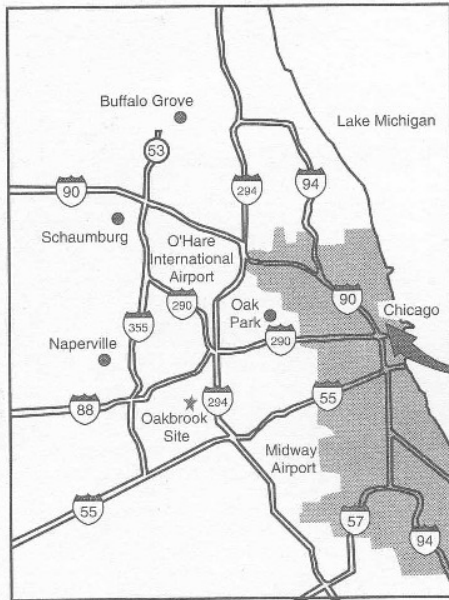

IF YOU ARE DRIVING

RIC is easily accessible by car. From U.S. 41 (Lake Shore Drive) south, exit at Ontario Street or Grand Avenue. From U.S. 41 north, exit at Grand Avenue, turning right on McClurg Court. From Interstates 90/94, exit at Ohio Street, follow to McClurg Court, turn north to Huron Street. From Interstate 290 (Congress Parkway) turn north on Columbus Drive (which becomes Fairbanks Court), turning east on Erie Street and north onto McClurg Court. The outpatient/visitors' parking lots are located at 321 E. Erie, between Erie and Ontario just west of the CBS building, and at 227 E. Huron, at the corner of Huron and St. Clair. (Look for the SELF PARK signs.)

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

The Rehabilitation Institute of Chicago (RIC) is located just east of North Michigan Avenue near the John Hancock Building. Buses run north and south on Michigan Avenue and on Fairbanks Court, which is a half block west of RIC. The bus lines connect with other north/south subway trains and METRA suburban trains.
